<p>DAY: 36 SUNDAY FEB. 24</p>	<p>Loving God, help us to be open and attentive to hearing one another's stories. Guide us in discernment that we may never be dismissive, skeptical or stubborn when listening to the voices of our brothers and sisters.</p>
<p>DAY: 37 MONDAY FEB. 25</p>	<p>You created us in your image, God. Help us to recognize You in each other, especially those who come to us in need at the border, in the street, in the places we work, and even in our homes. Let us love others as You love us.</p>
<p>DAY: 38 TUESDAY FEB. 26</p>	<p>God, you have gifted us with intelligence and inventiveness that we sometimes use against ourselves by creating weapons. Protect us from abusing the power you've given us. Show us the way to use our abilities to create peace and unity.</p>
<p>DAY: 39 WEDNESDAY FEB. 27</p>	<p>Today we pray for those without a home. We ask You to look after those on the streets facing the cold. Provide a safe place of rest for those in need. Move upon our hearts so we may assist our brothers and sisters.</p>
<p>DAY: 40 THURSDAY FEB. 28</p>	<p>God, we pray for the will to act to protect our common home. Awaken our heads and hearts to recognize how our choices today may effect those who follow us, and then help us to do something that will sustain our environment.</p>
<p>DAY: 41 FRIDAY MAR. 1</p>	<p>We pray for people in places of conflict around the world. Influence leaders and their followers to put down their arms and seek resolution to what is causing them to destroy one another. Restore to wholeness all victims of violence.</p>
<p>DAY: 42 SATURDAY MAR. 2</p>	<p>God, we ask for courage to not be afraid of people who are different from us. Let us not look at outward appearance, but toward words and deeds. May we find common ground in our humanity and in Your love for each of us.</p>
