2nd Reading: 2 Corinthians 5:20-6:2

Gospel: Matthew 6:1-6, 16-18

"Even Now"

Cach year I am struck by the first two words of today's reading from the Prophet Joel — Even now. Even now, in the midst of disease, division, and despair.
